- Set Clear Boundaries
- Model Calmness

Tips for Teachers

- Record on Guard.
- Stay Calm and Consistent.
- Build Trust.
- Teach Alternatives to express their feelings.
- Collaborate with parents.

Tips for students to Avoid Violence at School

- **Respect Everyone:** Treat classmates and staff with kindness and fairness.
- **Stay Calm:** Walk away from heated situations and avoid reacting aggressively.
- **Use Words, Not Fists:** Talk through problems instead of fighting.
- **Be Inclusive:** Invite others to join activities and show empathy.
- **Choose Positive Friends:** Stick with people who encourage good behavior.
- **Join Peace Programs:** Support school campaigns promoting kindness and understanding.

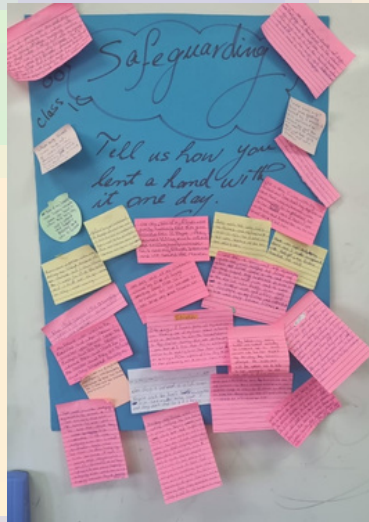
